Chloe Styler is that rare talent who stops you in your tracks and makes you listen. Really listen. Hailing from the Gold Coast, Australia, the singer songwriter has a voice that's both warm and electric, with lyrics that feel like they're lifted straight from her diary. With a knack for honest storytelling and earworm hooks, she's played everywhere from Enmore Theatre and Suncorp Stadium to The Bluebird Café in the USA.

In 2024, Chloe earned the title of 'Breakout Artist of the Year' at the Gold Coast Music Awards and for good reason. She independently ticked over 600k streams, released a string of singles produced by Grammy-winning producer Luke Wooten, and showcased internationally. She's been quietly carving her own path and now she's starting to turn heads far beyond home.

On stage, Chloe brings a magnetic energy that captivates audiences, from sold-out headline shows to major festivals like Americana Fest (USA), Big Red Bash, CMA Fest (USA), Deni Ute Muster, and Falls Festival Byron Bay. She's shared the stage with international icons like Gladys Knight, Tony Hadley (ex-Spandau Ballet), and Nik Kershaw, performing at legendary venues across the country including The Tivoli, Forum and The Gov. Chloe has also supported a star-studded lineup of local acts such as Kingswood, Shannon Noll, and Jem Cassar-Daley, all while wholeheartedly connecting with audiences wherever she plays.

Chloe Styler's music is bold, authentic, and unmistakably her own. With two Queensland Music Awards nominations, a finalist spot in the Vanda & Young Global Songwriting Competition, and two international showcases with Sounds Australia under her belt, she is undoubtedly one of the most exciting homegrown artists to keep an eye on.
