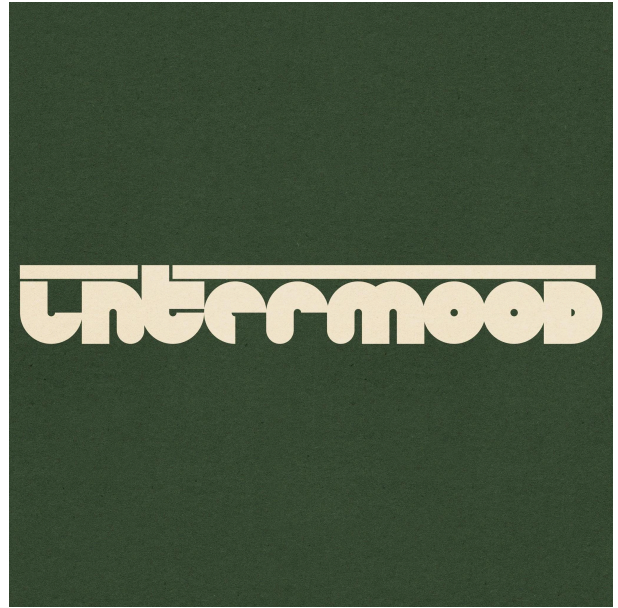


Intermood

Intermood artist biography

Radiating with a burning desire to make people move, Intermood's heaving live performances have turned heads within Melbourne/Naarm's thriving instrumental scene. Swearing an allegiance to always bring the ruckus, the group's blend of instrumental psychedelic jazz and high energy neo-disco has emerged out of sweaty sold out shows within Australia's music capital, leading them to the stages of the Melbourne International Jazz Festival and Strawberry Fields Festival.

Intermood's evolving sound fuses the live dance music of Mildlife and L'Éclair with the housey rhythms of Todd Terje. Having created a buzz with the release of their debut EP, 'Casuarina', the group are set to continue carving out their own space within Melbourne/Naarm's instrumental and dance worlds.
